## AfHEA UHC training programme

The AfHEA training on Universal Health Coverage is a core Programme of the Association's Business plan. It targets Ministries of Health and related Government agencies, local research bodies or other related national or regional organizations that need skills in the training on UHC but do not currently have sufficient capacities to undertake in-house technical analysis in this area or have such capacities available locally to them. The content of the trainings is based on priorities defined by targeted actors and reported after a wide survey in 19 African countries and 3 regional institutions. It comprises:

- => Universal coverage mechanisms such as design and implementation of health insurance, exemption schemes, conditional cash transfers, vouchers, equity funds, etc.
- => Good design principles and practice (eg integrated versus fragmented risk pools)
- => How to ensure equity or maximum coverage for vulnerable groups
- => Provider payment mechanisms
- => Risk management techniques
- => Stakeholder analysis and engagement
- => Actuarial analysis
- => Adequate monitoring and evaluation mechanisms
- => Fiscal space analysis,
- => Health sector needs-based resource allocation,
- => Costing tools such as Marginal budgeting for bottlenecks (MBB), One Health tool, LIST, etc.
- => Benefit incidence analysis,
- => Discrete choice experiments to help address the acute HRH crisis in Africa
- => Public Expenditure Reviews and Tracking Survey (PER/PETS),
- => National Health Accounts (NHA),
- => Results-based financing



The first AfHEA workshop was held in Dakar (27 Jan 2013 -7 Fev 2014) for Francophone countries. In 2014, a second Francophone and two Anglophone workshops will be organized, in addition to specific sessions demanded by AfHEA partners.
