## BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVE

- **Strong PHC systems lead to improved health system goals:**  
The evidence base clearly supports the conclusion that PHC system performance is deterministic of the achievement of overall health system goals and suggests that the achievement of health goals (improved patient health outcomes, improved responsiveness to patient needs, and fairness in financial provision and protection) depends on the delivery of efficient, equitable, and high quality care
- **Strong PHC systems are well integrated into the broader health system architecture**
- **We make a preliminary review of PHC expenditures in countries in the African region**

- Analytical work prepared by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and WHO based on country health accounts information.

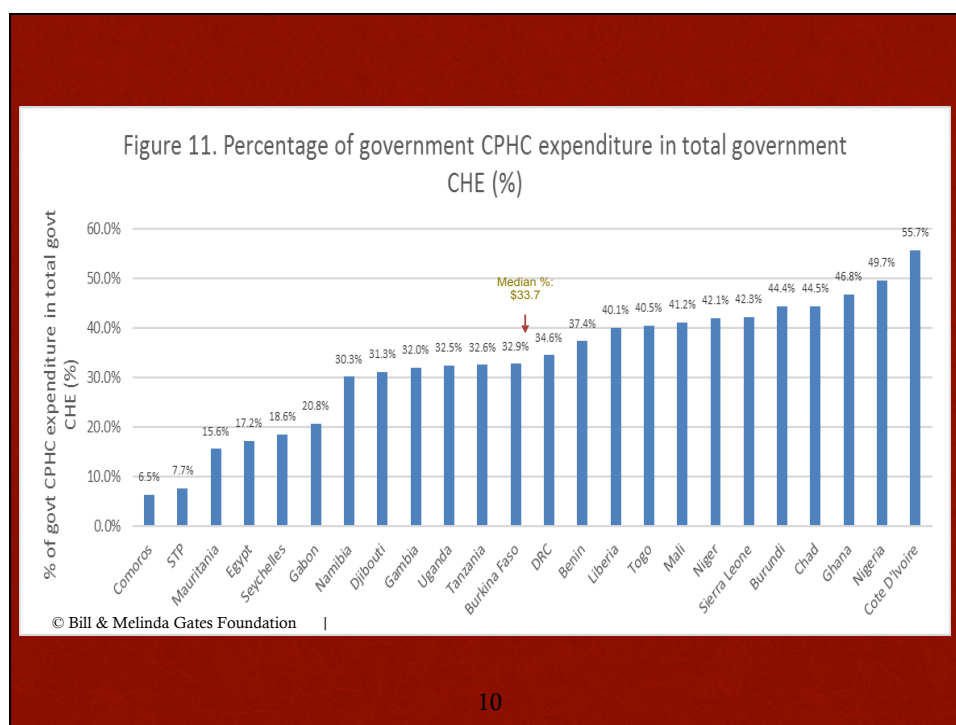
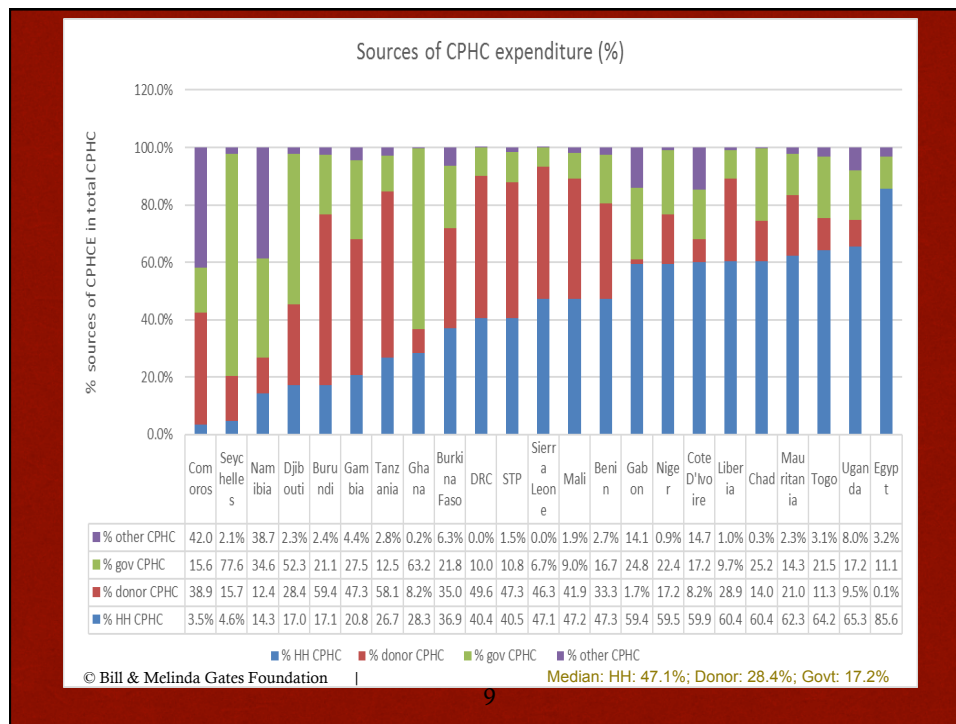
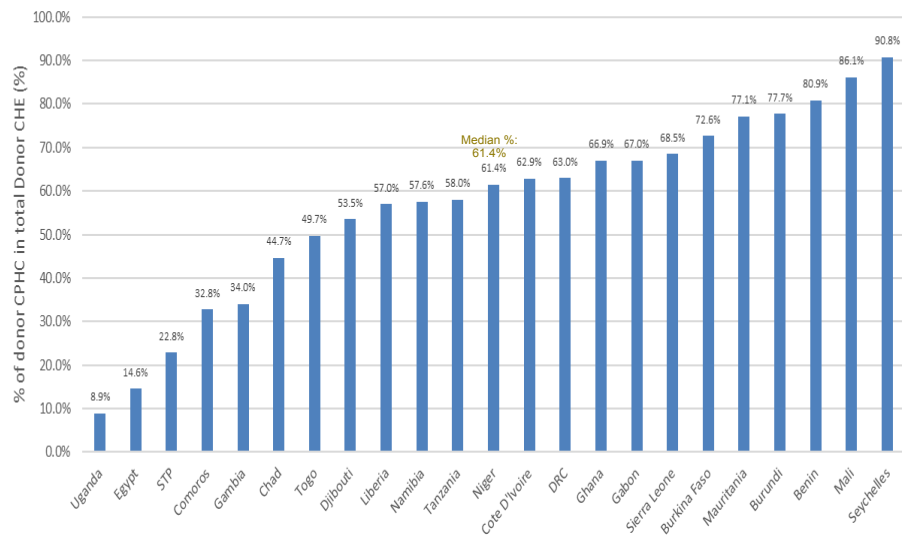
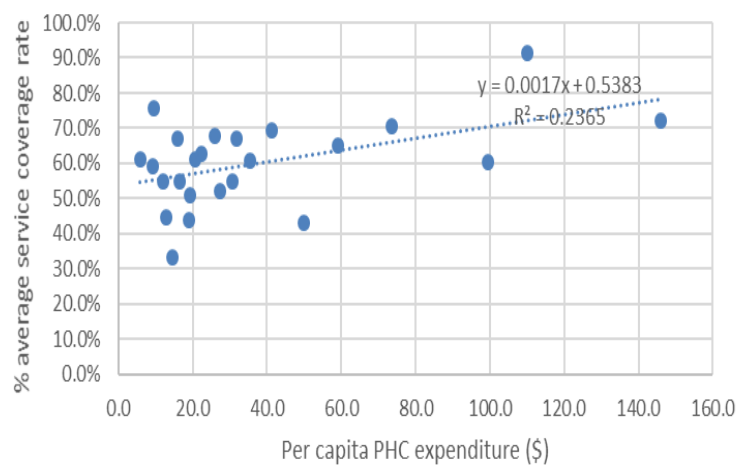


Figure 12. Percentage of donor CPHC in total donor CHE (%)
